What Do You Like Doing?

Vocabulary

Essential Vocabulary:

Unusual – Something that is rare or not commonly seen or done.

Gardening – The activity of growing and maintaining plants, flowers, or vegetables in a garden.

Painting – Creating artwork by applying paint to a surface such as paper, canvas, or walls.

Drawing – Making pictures or designs using pencils, pens, or other tools.

Cycling – Riding a bicycle for exercise, transport, or leisure.

Collecting – Gathering and organising items of interest, such as stamps, coins, or books.

Knitting – Crafting fabric by interlocking yarn using needles.

Sewing – Using a needle and thread to create or repair clothing and textiles.

Craft – Making decorative or functional items by hand, such as pottery or jewellery.

Hiking – Walking long distances in nature, often in the mountains or countryside.

Skating – Gliding on ice or a smooth surface using ice skates or roller skates.

Skateboarding – Riding a skateboard, often involving tricks and stunts.

Cooking – Preparing food by combining ingredients and using heat.

Baking – Cooking food, especially bread, cakes, or pastries, in an oven.
